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Community

Mount Royal Academy is a private Catholic school nestled in the hills of New Hampshire's Dartmouth - Lake Sunapee Region. Since 1994 the faculty, families and friends of Mount Royal have striven to provide not only a quality education to the children of our community, but most importantly a formation in Christian faith and morals. What began as an elementary school, grades Kindergarten through 8th, has grown to include a preschool with three and four year old programs and a liberal arts college preparatory High School. Mount Royal Academy is thankful to be the first lay-founded independent school to receive Catholic School recognition from the Bishop of Manchester, NH. It serves 22 towns and cities from all over the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Region; 15% of the students are minorities.

The high school currently enrolls 55 students.

Mount Royal Academy is accredited by the National Association of Private and Independent Catholic School until 2020.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a seven block schedule. Students must take six academic classes per year, as well as one fine arts elective and physical education.

The school follows the esteemed Great Books tradition by reading and dialoguing with the best thinkers of Western Civilization. Seniors must complete a college-level essay, orally present their synthesis of themes and ideas learned from the great literary works, and then defend their essay in front of the entire high school student body and faculty.

Mount Royal Academy is partnered with the New Hampshire Community Colleges and Holy Apostles College and Seminary, which affords our students the opportunity to receive college credit as upperclassmen via dual-enrollment. There are over 30 college courses available, including on-campus, off-campus, and distance learning.

Honors classes are offered in select courses.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

GPA is computed using quality points. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 25 credits is required for graduation.

In addition, each student must complete a 100-hour community service graduation requirement. AP and Honors classes are weighted higher. Credits are awarded at the end of a course, and the overall GPA is computed in June.
